Posters:

Qualifying size: 8.5” x 14” (Please note that this is a change in size from previous years)

1. The theme “**Bring Our Missing Children Home**” must be written somewhere on the poster.
2. The poster design may be in any medium, including (but not limited to) water color, oil, crayon, acrylic, pencil, ink, or magic marker. Wood, plastic, metal, glass, or other breakable materials are not allowed.
3. Posters must be mailed flat — not rolled or in tubes.
4. Contestants must follow all rules to qualify.
5. Do not include any personal information (name, age, school, etc.) on the front of the poster.
6. A completed entry form must be securely attached to the poster.
7. Each entry must be the original work of **one** student only. Any plagiarized work or “joint efforts” will be disqualified with all winnings forfeited.
8. The theme’s message must be clearly represented in the entry.
9. Work becomes the property of the Arkansas Attorney General’s Office and will not be returned. However, special arrangements can be made on a case-by-case basis by contacting the numbers listed below.
10. The winning 5th-grade entry will be submitted to the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention’s National Missing Children’s Day Poster Contest.

Prizes

- ◆ 1st Place: Trophy and \$50 cash
- ◆ 2nd Place: Trophy and \$25 cash
- ◆ 3rd Place: Trophy and \$15 cash



****First, second, and third place winners will be chosen in six grade divisions.*

The six (6) grade divisions will be each individual grade level K-5.

Winners will be invited to an awards ceremony in Little Rock to be held in April, 2012.
